

Introduction

The New "EasysFolding" Map

Covering the Western Half of Victoria, portion of the Riverina (N.S.W.) and portion of South Australia, the map deals with all roads recently completed.

The Eastern Half of Victoria (including portion of N.S.W., the Riverina and the A.C.T.) is sold separately at 1/-.

Outlet Maps

To eliminate the difficulty which most motorists experience in finding their way out of cities, a number of Outlet Maps of the various centres within the scope of this publication are included. The two Outlet Maps for Melbourne are supplemented by detailed speedometer charts.

Special Tourist Maps

For the assistance of those tourists who desire to make a centre of one or other of the popular holiday resorts such as Cowes and Phillip Island, the Dandenong Ranges, the Grampians, Daylesford and Hepburn Springs, and Lorne, special Tourist Maps covering these districts are included. The numerous beauty spots and feature points in these districts, accessible either by road or by walking tracks, are clearly shown on the Maps.

Accommodation

Under the heading of "Where to Go—Where to Stay," a special section comprises an alphabetical list of principal towns and holiday resorts, the mileage of each by road from Melbourne, and the various hotels and guest houses, etc., which are available.

"Central Victoria" and "South Gippsland"

As full details of roads and places in the area of approximately 60 miles round Melbourne, and in that of South Gippsland—an area intersected by a network of perfectly surfaced roads, and now regarded as "The Motorists' Touring Ground"—could not be shown on the scale of this map (13 miles to 1 inch), two special large-scale maps (5 miles to 1 inch) have also been issued. The former—the "Book-Folding" Map of Central Victoria—virtually covers "60 to 100 Miles Round Melbourne," "50 Miles Round Geelong," and "30 Miles Round Ballarat." It is obtainable at 2/-, while the South Gippsland "Book-Folding" Map, a similar production, and an extension eastwards of it, is priced at 1/-.

Victoria for the Tourist

Wide Diverseness of Scenery

ALTHOUGH the smallest Australian State (the island State of Tasmanía being the smallest in the Commonwealth), Victoria has the second largest population, and, so far as roads are concerned, possesses the very material advantage of compactness. The multiplicity of radiating highways, and good roads inter-connecting them, provide a network that covers almost the whole of the State, and this wonderful, far-flung system of highways has earned for Victoria the name of the GOOD ROADS STATE.

Victoria possesses a remarkable diversity of scenery — mountains, valleys and plains — also the highest through road in Australia, 6260 ft., where it rounds Mt. Hotham in the Australian Alps. It is favoured also with an equable climate, the thermometer in comparatively few instances rising above 100 degrees, and less frequently dropping below freezing point, except, of course, in the higher altitudes where snow and ice in winter provide facilities for snow sports — skating, ski-ing, tobogganing, etc.—at Mount Donna Buang (58 miles from Melbourne), at Lake Mountain (70 miles), at Mt. Buller (141 miles), at Mt. Buffalo (208 miles), and at Mt. Hotham (228 miles).

In the Western District of Victoria the coastal areas are most picturesque; there are fine open grazing areas and prosperous towns right across to the South Australian border, and farther north are the prolific wheat fields of the Wimmera and Mallee districts. The central and north-central district contains most of the old gold fields, where millions of pounds worth of the precious metal was won, the country being undulating and becoming hilly in the eastern districts. In the eastern areas of Gippsland and South Gippsland some of the most interesting country exists. It is hilly to mountainous in nature, though a fair stretch of open, rolling country is threaded by the Prince's Highway (east) for over 200 miles.

In the north-east is the really mountainous country, including the Australian Alps; the scenery is magnificent, and much of it is accessible by good roads. Thus, generally, the western portion of the State can be termed level to undulating, gradually becoming hilly toward the east, when it merges into mountain ranges, the peaks of which in many instances exceed 6000 ft. in altitude.





Outlets from Melbourne

Maps of Melbourne Outlets appear on pages 11 and 13.

Owing to the difficulty experienced by many motorists in finding a course through the metropolitan thoroughfares to the main roads, the various outlets from the city proper are herewith tersely described to points from where the divers routes can easily be followed on the Main Map at page 59.

No. 1 OUTLET—Direct Route

To Geelong Road—Prince's Highway (West).

(Four Outlets—Nos. 1, 2, 3 and 4)

Set Speedo. at Zero

- 90.0 MELBOURNE. Central Post Office (Elizabeth Street). Proceed westerly (uphill) along Bourke Street.
- 0.6 Turn right at G.P.O. into Spencer Street,
- 1.4 Turn left into Hawke Street.
- 1.5 Turn right into Ireland Street.
- 1.7 NORTH MELBOURNE.—Swing to left over railway bridge and along Dynon Road.
- 3.1 Pass under railway bridge.
- 3.5 Cross Maribyrnong River Bridge.

- 3.8 Cross railway bridge.
- 4.0 Pick up tramline and follow.
- 4.1 FOOTSCRAY,—Tram Junction,— Keep straight on. (Western Highway — Ballarat road branches to right.)
- 4.5 Cross road—Bear to left into 3-chain road (Prince's Highway West), leaving tramlines.
- 4.8 WEST FOOTSCRAY.—Cross railway bridge and keep straight on along Highway to Geelong, a centre from which many routes radiate.

NOTE.—This outlet leads also to Anglesea, Lorne, Apollo Bay, Colac, Cressy, as well as to Portarlington, Queenscliff, Barwon Heads and Torquay—all shown on the "Easy-Folding" Map.

No. 2 OUTLET—Alternative Route

To Geelong Road—Prince's Highway (West).

Set Speedo, at Zero

- 00.0 MELBOURNE. Central Post Office (Elizabeth Street). Proceed northerly along Elizabeth Street.
- 0.6 Cross Victoria Street (tramlines).
- 0.9 HAYMARKET JUNCTION. —

 Bear to left along Flemington
 Road (following electric tramlines).
- 2.1 Turn left along branch tramline into Racecourse Road (opposite Royal Park Entrance).
- 2.3 Pass under railway bridge.
- 2.8 Pass under railway bridge.

- 3.0 NEWMARKET,—Turn left into Smithfield Road and pass Flemington Racecourse (on right).
- 3.9 Cross Maribyrnong River Bridge.
- 4.6 JUNCTION.—Bear to left on to Prince's Highway (West)— Geelong Road. (Western Highway—Ballarat Road—qoes straight on).
- 4.8 Cross tramlines (Droop Street).
- 5.1 Cross tramlines (Barkly Street).
- 5.5 WEST FOOTSCRAY.—Cross Railway Bridge and keep straight on as shown on "Easy-folding" Map.

NOTE.—This route is 0.7 miles longer than that via Outlet No. 1.

Outlets from Melbourne (Continued)-

No. 3 OUTLET—Alternative Route

To Geelong Road—Prince's Highway (West).

(Via Short Road to Williamstown and Kororoit Creek Road)

NOTE.—This route is 1.7 miles longer than Outlet No. 1, and one mile longer than Outlet No. 2, but for those starting from a Southern or South-eastern suburb of the metropolis it provides a desirable exit if the Williamstown (Punt) Road is joined near Port Melbourne.

Set Speedo, at Zero

- 00.0 MELBOURNE. Central Post
 Office (Elizabeth Street).
 - Proceed southerly along Elizabeth Street (crossing Collins Street tramlines) to end at Flinders Street Railway Station.
- 0.3 Turn right into Flinders Street.
- 0.6 Turn left and pass under railway viaduct.
- 0.7 Cross Queen's Bridge over the Yarra, and follow tramlines.
- 0.8 Pass under railway bridge.
- 1.1 Tram Junction.—Follow tramlines straight on.
- 1.4 Pass under railway bridge.
- 2.5 PORT MELBOURNE. Turn right into Graham Street (leaving tramlines).
- 2.7 Cross railway (gates).
- 3.1 Turn left on to Williamstown (concrete) Road.
- 5.0 Cross River Yarra by punt.
 (Punt plies daily from 6.30
 a.m. till midnight on week
 days and holidays, and from 7
 a.m. till 11 p.m. on Sundays.

- Charges—Car and driver, 6d., passengers, 1d. each.) After leaving punt swing to left
- along The Strand.
- 5.3 Turn right into North Road and keep straight on; Strand curves to left at hotel.
- NEWPORT.—Turn sharp to left into Melbourne Road.
- 6.8 Turn right into Station Street (school on corner).
- 7.0 NORTH WILLIAMSTOWN. Cross railway (gates) and keep straight on along Kororoit Creek Road (concrete).
- 8.9 Williamstown Racecourse on left.
- 9.1 Cross railway.
- 9.5 Road to left to Altona.
- 10.0 Cross Kororolt Creek bridge.
- 10.5 Cross railway (Meibourne—Geelong line). C.O.R. siding on right.
- 11.5 Road to left to Altona.
- 13.0 JUNCTION.—Bear to left along Prince's Highway (West)— Geelong Road—which is thence followed as shown on the "Easy-folding" Map.

No. 4 OUTLET—New Alternative Route

To Geelong Road—Prince's Highway (West)

- 0.3 Turn left into Latrobe Street, and follow to end at Adderly St.
- 0.9 Turn right.
- 1.1 Turn left into Dudley Street.
- 1.3 Pass under railway bridge.
- 1.4 Cross road-turn right.
- 1.8 Cross branch railway.
- 2.0 Cross Canal bridge.

- 3.4 Napier Street Bridge (Maribyrnong River).
- 3.8 Cross railway (gates), and swing to left.
- 3.9 Bear right and follow tramway.
- 4.3 Tramway turns left; bear right and then immediately to left (keeping railway on right).
- 4.6 WEST FOOTSCRAY. Railway Bridge—Curve to left.
- 4.7 Keep straight on along Geelong
 Road Prince's Highway
 (West), as shown on the
 "Easy-folding" Map.

NOTE.—The mileage for this route is the same as Outlet No. 1—via

Dynon Road.

Motor Camping

WITH the increase in the popularity of motor camping, proclaimed areas have been provided throughout Victoria and the adjacent States, but, in spite of this provision, it might be said that the majority of motorists prefer to select their own location, with a view to securing seclusion, and for those the following hints will be of some assistance.

The first essential is serviceable equipment, and in order to avoid over-loading the car, this should be restricted as far as possible to exclude what may be described as "junk." Tents, lamps, tables, stools, stretchers, safes and cooking utensils have been specially designed with that object in view, and can be purchased at reasonable prices. As part of equipment a first-aid outfit should not be overlooked.

As to the location for the camp, it is desirable to select an elevated position providing some shelter from wind and weather, and where fresh water is available at easy distance.

An important point to remember is that tent ropes should be slackened slightly each evening, as dew or a shower will cause them to contract, and pull their pegs from the ground. By use of a lead-light or a spot-light, electric illumination is available to the motor camper by using either the car battery or a spare battery as the source of supply.

It should be noted that wattle blossom, heath and other wild flowers may not legally be gathered, and prompt action is to be taken by the Forests Commission to check the practice. Application is being made by the Commission for penalties ranging up to £20 for detected offenders, and the services of the police are to be sought in stopping and examining motor cars and other vehicles suspected of containing plants and flowers illegally gathered.

Generally, there is no restriction in regard to the lighting of fires, providing every precaution is taken, but in some of the areas of Crown lands special places have been set apart for the lighting of fires, and where these are provided they must be used. If it is desired to camp on private property, permission, of course, must be obtained from the owner.

The Murray Valley Highway

An Important Connecting Artery

Commentuments of the State (350 miles from Melbourne via Omeo), the Murray Valley Highway follows the course of the stream for upwards of 500 miles to Mildura, and continues through Merbein to Abbotsford Bridge, within four miles of Wentworth. For the first hundred miles the river is closely followed through most attractive valley scenery. On reaching Little Plain (Granya Junction), 64 miles, the highway bears south to Tallangatta, then west to Wodonga at 112 miles. An alternative, and a shorter, route lies along the valley proper from Granya Junction to Albury and Wodonga, crossing en route the Reservoir Bridge into New South Wales, the distance by this route being 99 miles.

Beyond Wodonga the highway links up Rutherglen, Yarrawonga, Strathmerton, Nathalia and Wyuna before reaching Echuca, at 259 miles from Corryong. Continuing, the towns passed through are Cohuna, Kerang and Swan Hill at 356 miles, then on to Nyah, Piangil, Boundary Bend and through Bannerton to Murray Valley Junction at the end of the Calder Highway, at 471 miles, the Murray Valley Highway then being followed to Mildura, 517 miles from Corryong. This route is clearly defined on the map, together with intermediate distances in black, and intermediate total distances between the larger centres in red.

The Murray Valley Highway is important in that it connects all roads running north through Victoria to the Murray, and thus provides a yery desirable link in local road communications. Naturally, it also intersects all routes leading from New South Wales across the Murray, which enhances its value. The nature of the country passed through varies. Commencing in mountainous country it runs among the hills on the first stage, then becomes undulating, and the further westward, the easier and opener the country, the river having a fall of only a few inches per mile.

The Grampians

Rugged Peaks, Waterfalls, and Wildflowers

A PECULIAR feature of the Grampians is that many of the peaks and spurs rise on slopes from the west and suddenly end with precipitous sides in the east, presenting clear-cut, sharp escarpments, and in their several formations have led to features receiving somewhat romantic and characteristic names. For instance, there is the Signal Rock, Point Sunshine, Wonderland Peak, Gates of the West Wind, The Sundial, Cape Horn, The Watch Tower, Venus' Bath, Grand Canyon, Woolpack Rocks, and so on

Hall's Gap has been aptly described as "The Gate to the Grampians." Through it a fine graded road leads into the heart of the ranges to Mt. Victory, and continues to the Wartook Reservoir and McKenzie River Falls, all through most picturesque surroundings. The road continues northerly and reaches the large Wimmera district town of Horsham, on the Western Highway. From Hall's Gap another road runs south along Fyan's Creek, crossing the ridge connecting the appropriately named Serra Range, and from Mt. William falls away into the Wannon Valley, and ultimately reaches Dunkeld in 50 miles.

On the several watercourses in the Grampians are very pretty waterfalls — Clematis Falls, Epacris Falls, Turret and Pansy Falls, and Five Cascades — to name a few. But the glory and splendour of the Grampians is best seen in early spring — from the end of August to well into October — when wild flowers bloom in great profusion and present an unforgettable sight. This beautiful district can be reached via the Western Highway, through Melton, Bacchus Marsh, Ballarat and Ararat, 126 miles, from where Hall's Gap is 30 miles further and 156 miles from Melbourne; or from Ararat to Stawell (145 miles), thence to the Gap at 162 miles from Melbourne. The highway is excellent to Stawell, thence a good gravel road to the Grampians—17 miles.

COMMENCING practically at Geelong, the Great Ocean Road extends in an unbroken line for 180 miles through Torquay, Anglesea, Lorne, Apollo Bay, Princetown, Port Campbell and Peterborough to Warrnambool. Although longer, it has become an important and a popular alternative route to the Prince's Highway over the section to Warrnambool, which measures 118 miles from Geelong—a difference of 62 miles. Without doubt it is the finest stretch of coastal road in the Commonwealth, as from Torquay to a few miles past Apollo Bay the road so faithfully follows the coastline that the tourist is rarely out of sight of the ocean, while the road for very many miles is actually at the waterline or up to 100 ft., 200 ft. and even 300 ft. above sea level.

The Great Ocean Road links up a large number of popular watering places — Airey's Inlet; Eastern View, where the Ocean Road Golf Links are situated; Lorne, the "Pearl of the Pacific", Wye, and Apollo Bay, another beautiful holiday haunt. Genesis of Touring

Right back in the old cycling days, long before the advent of the automobile, the desirability of having complete and accurate information of holiday resorts and roads was so manifest that Mr. Geo. R. Broadbent decided to prepare a Road Map and Guide.
